

## OAKFIELD INVENTORY 2009

Properties at 80 and 82 North Main Street, Oakfield, NY . Formerly the Oakfield Presbyterian Church and manse. Compiled by David Hale for the Presbytery of Genesee Valley. Harris Wilcox Inc. believes it to be substantially correct. However, there are no guarantees, expressed or implied, regarding the veracity of the inventory.

1. **SANCTUARY:**

20 wooden pews with cushions. Many copies of The Hymnbook (1955), The Presbyterian Hymnal (1990), and RSV Bibles; small wooden storage cabinet; audio system control box with five components (2003); Allen Protégé electric organ; Story and Clark upright piano (1970 plaque); communion table with six offering plates, large Bible, brass cross; wooden pulpit; 11 folding chairs for choir; two stands with artificial flowers; three wooden straight back chairs; large wooden cross; American and church flags; Last Supper tapestry on north wall

2. **NORTH VESTIBULE:**

Schulmerich Campinale, digital instrument. Cards in office; two candelabra with stands; portrait of Jesus; wooden baptismal font

3. **CHOIR ROOM:**

Bent upright piano; two door metal closet with choir robes; two four-shelf metal units; four-shelf metal rack with percussion instruments; 15 folding chairs; one wooden table; three music stands; two large plastic storage tubs, one with stuffed animals

4. **ADULT ROOM:**

one wooden bookcase; one music stand; one metal coat rack; one Last Supper print

5. **LOUNGE:**

one long table; 17 various chairs; two sofas; one small end table

6. **HALL:**

four book cases with varied books; one bench; one coat rack; one small end table.

7. **KITCHENETTE:**

electric hot plate; one bench; two-door metal storage cabinet

8. **CONFERENCE ROOM:**

three tables; 18 chairs; one metal two-door storage cabinet; one small two-door chest with television

9. **PASTOR'S STUDY:**

six book cases; two desks; one four-drawer metal file cabinet; four chairs; one desk-top computer

10. **OFFICE:**

six chairs; one desk; five metal four-drawer file cabinets; one card table with desk-top computer; one large work table; one two-door metal storage cabinet; one telephone; one long storage unit, in two sections; one JP Deskjet 810c printer; one Canon Imagerunner 220 copier; office supplies (paper, envelopes, etc.)

11. **SERVICE BUILDING/LOWER LEVEL:**

nook at foot of stairs, coat rack with hangers and 23+ table cloths

12. **KITCHEN:**  
three refrigerators, two Frigidaire; ten-burner Universal gas stove; four service carts; one Hotpoint microwave; one two-burner coffee maker; three square work tables; large quantity of pots, pans, china, and silverware.
13. **STORAGE AREA OFF KITCHEN:**  
one set steel shelves; four folding chairs; one table; four coffee makers, various sizes; one two-door storage cabinet; one extension ladder; cleaning supplies.
14. **DINING ROOM:**  
twelve long tables; two square tables, as in kitchen; fifty chairs; one high chair; one coat rack; one Kurtzmann upright piano, with hymnals and Bibles; one sound system; one music stand; one Toshiba TV with DVD player.
15. **FURNACE ROOM:** (Note: two Weil-McLain boilers, one Weil-McLain hot-water heater and control panels remain with the real estate)  
two snow shovels; cleaning supplies

#### **ROOMS UNDER SANCTUARY – NORTH SIDE**

16. **MUSIC ROOM:**  
two two-door storage cabinets; four metal file cabinets; one Roland EP-5 keyboard; collection of silk flowers; substantial collection of sheet music.
17. **NEXT ROOM:**  
one long table; one small table; ten chairs; three book cases; one two-door storage cabinet; one TV
18. **BEGINNERS ROOM:** two small tables; two storage shelves; collection of toys and books
19. **NURSERY:** two wooden rocking chairs; one storage cabinet; collection of toys
20. **STORAGE ROOM AT END OF HALL:**  
one two-door cabinet; one upright vacuum cleaner; six chairs; one book case; one high chair; miscellaneous items.
21. **SENIOR YOUTH ROOM:**  
one small storage cabinet; two sofas; two easy chairs; one book case, with books; one ping-pong table; one Foosball game
22. **GRADES 1-2:** one long table; seven chairs; one book case; one two-door wooden cabinet
23. **GRADES 3-6:** two tables; eight chairs; one wooden book case.

No attempt has been made to inventory the contents of the attic. There are a few 19<sup>th</sup> century pulpit Bibles and a substantial amount of miscellaneous items including Christmas decorations and items for Christmas pageants.

The house at 82 Main Street is empty except for a **refrigerator which sells with the real estate**, a few curtains, and a few miscellaneous items in the basement and attic

The storage building behind the house contains a snow blower, two power lawn mowers; and a few miscellaneous items.
